

- I, Rachel the Curious, as the Queen of the Kingdom of Stabilitas, in my authority as the embodiment of The Crown, hereby establish a Bill of Rights for all subjects of The Crown.
 - All subjects of The Crown have the right to freedom of speech; freedom of expression; freedom of association and peaceful assembly; freedom of the press; freedom to petition The Crown, Parliament, or both; freedom of religion and political opinion, and privacy in their own home.
 - Mentally capable and non-criminal subjects of The Crown over the age of 21 have the right to bear arms in a manner regulated by Parliament.
 - All subjects of The Crown have the right to be safe from violent crime and to expect justice when violent crime against them, their family members, or their friends does occur.
 - No subject of The Crown shall be discriminated against on the basis of macronational citizenship or nationality, class, race, sex (including pregnancy or menstruation), disability or medical condition, criminal victimization, sexual orientation, transgender identity, religion, or political opinion. This prohibition of discrimination also prohibits discrimination based on the absence of any of the aforementioned traits.
 - No subject of The Crown shall be held in slavery or involuntary servitude.
 - Every subject of The Crown, when indicted of a crime, has a right to a trial of jury of their peers. Every subject of The Crown is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
 - · The issuing of this Bill of Rights should not be interpreted as

- implying that these rights didn't exist until the Bill of Rights was established. These rights existed since the foundation of the Kingdom of Stabilitas.
- This list is not a conclusive list of all rights subjects of The Crown are entitled to.

A Bill of Rights for all subjects of The Crown is hereby issued by The Crown on the 17th of December in the 2020th year of the Common Era.
