


2011 NEW BANKNOTE

Al Gore praises Yudhoyono on green house gas emissions cuts

Jakarta (9/1), Nobel laureate and former US vice president Al Gore praised President Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono for raising the world's attention on the importance of green house gas emissions cuts, saying that Indonesia had the resources to be a geothermal super power.

Speaking in front of 350 participants from 21 countries, the majority being Indonesians, at the Asia Pacific Summit for the Climate Project, Gore thanked Yudhoyono's vision, courage and leadership on the climate change issue during the United Nation Climate Change Conference (COP 15) in Copenhagen, Denmark.

During COP 15, Yudhoyono announced plans to voluntarily cut emissions by 26 percent by 2020 using the national budget with the formal letter submitted to the United Nations office.

Gore said that Yudhoyono spoke at a time when no leader of the G77 nations was willing to stand up, take the initiative and cut them all. Therefore, he added, the action had broken the long standing deadlock that had frustrated progress in some areas. He said it was an amendable piece of progress.

"I respect him greatly and admire his leadership. [Yudhoyono's] historic pledge that he made on

the eve of Copenhagen is going to continue to bring great things to the world and Indonesia," he said.

Gore said that developing countries in the Asia Pacific region were more vulnerable to the impact of climate change because they had a larger alliance of agriculture. However, he added, the region also had plenty of opportunities to deal with climate change.

"Indonesia, as one example, is the world's third largest geothermal producer for electricity, while the Philippines comes in second place. Indonesia could be the super power for

geothermal electricity and it can [also] advance Indonesia's economy," he said.

US Congresswoman Gabrielle Giffords shot in Arizona

Tucson, AZ (8/1), US Congresswoman Gabrielle Giffords was shot at a public event in Tucson, Arizona on Saturday. At least five were killed and several others were wounded in the shooting, including at least one of Giffords' staff. The shooting occurred at a Safeway supermarket where Giffords, a Democratic Party member who represented Arizona's 8th congressional district, had scheduled a public "Congress on Your Corner" event.

Giffords was widely reported as having died after the attack, but her public relations personnel later said she was undergoing surgery. Giffords was shot in the head at close range, and

according to the Pima County sheriff, Giffords, aged 40, died from the attack. *National Public Radio*, however, reported that there were conflicting reports about her death.

Giffords was airlifted to a nearby hospital and underwent emergency surgery. A spokesperson for University Medical Center said, "She is currently in surgery. She's alive," adding that nine other shooting victims had been taken to the hospital. After the surgery, the hospital announced Giffords was alive with a single gunshot wound to the head and that she was responsive.

The hospital also said that a nine-year-old was among those

killed in the shooting. David Gonzales, a US Marshal, said that federal judge John Roll also died from his wounds. President Barack Obama said the shooter killed a total of five people.

Peter Michaels, of Arizona
Public Media, said Giffords had
been speaking to several people
when someone began firing
randomly from around 4 feet (1.2
metres) away. The gunman
attempted to flee but was tackled
by an onlooker and taken into
police custody. Described as in
his late teens to early twenties,
he was later identified as 22year-old Jared Loughner, who
used a handgun in the attack.



BlackBerry Maker Given Two Weeks to Halt Porn Access in Indonesia

Jakarta (8/1). Communications and Information Technology Minister Tifatul Sembiring has set a fresh deadline for the BlackBerry manufacturer to block access to pornography sites on the smartphone.

He gave representatives from

the Indonesian office of Research in Motion, the Canadian manufacturer of BlackBerry, a two-week deadline to restrict access to pornographic Web sites or risk being shut down.

"We have repeatedly asked them to do it and we have given them some time. If they keep delaying, we will shut down their operation here because they fail to comply with our laws," Tifatul said.

The ministry has conducted a series of meetings with RIM's representatives to demand that the company establish a database center and server in Indonesia in order to satisfy the country's legal requirements.

Establishing the center is aimed at allowing authorities to conduct lawful interceptions of e-mail and other messages.

At the ministry's year-end review, Tifatul has said the

negotiation was almost final.

However, he was irked that the RIM officials had not held a meeting with the ministry again since then.

"We invited them for a meeting again, but they said they were on vacation back in Canada. That is not an excuse." he said.

The RIM offices in Jakarta and Singapore said their executives were not immediately available for comment.

If the company does not meet the deadline, Tifatul said the ministry would request the six domestic telecommunications operators of RIM's BlackBerry Internet Services to shut down their operations.

The Indonesian
Telecommunications Users
Group said it supported the
ministry's threat.

"This is not just about failing to

block access to porn sites, but it's more about failing to comply with our laws. The ministry should be firm with its threat," said Muhammad Jumadi, the group's secretary general.

He said a local database center and server would prevent Indonesian users from wasting bandwidth to transmit frequencies to RIM's data center in Canada, thus reducing the Internet service tariff.

In November, RIM announced an Indonesian subsidiary to provide marketing support for its BlackBerry smartphones and to comply with the 2008 Information and Electronic Transaction (ITE) Law. It also opened an after-sales office in the capital in August.

Indonesia has some 1.5 million BlackBerry users, or around 7.1 percent of the 21 million global
